Bridger Valley Joint Powers Board – Water Advisory



Water Restriction Advisory

Due to the ongoing water shortage at the State Line Dam, the Bridger Valley Joint Powers Board is advising all residents that restrictions on outdoor water use are expected to be implemented soon (As soon as May). These restrictions will apply to all outdoor watering, including lawns, gardens, and landscaping. Because of the limited water supply, we strongly recommend postponing any new planting or landscaping projects.

This notice applies to all customers served by BVJPB, the Town of Mountain View, and the Town of Lyman. It does not apply to residents who use private wells or hold river water rights.

To preserve adequate water supply throughout the spring and summer, the Board anticipates placing a full restriction on all outdoor watering. We understand that this may be inconvenient, but it is necessary to maintain reliable service for the community. A formal resolution outlining consequences for failing to comply is currently under consideration.

Residents with questions or concerns are welcome to address the Board during its regular meeting, held on the second Wednesday of each month. We continue to explore long-term solutions to prevent future shortages. With only one source of water available, options remain limited, but we are committed to finding improvements.

We appreciate your cooperation as we work together to protect our community's water resources.
